

September 27, 2010
Final Budget Hearing
Bonifay, Florida

The Holmes County Board of Commissioners met in Special Session on the above date with the following members present: Commissioner Kenneth Williams, Commissioner Jim King, Commissioner Phillip Music, and Commissioner Monty Merchant, Chairman of the Board.

Alice Vickers, Deputy Clerk, was present and kept the minutes.

Chairman Merchant opened the meeting with prayer and led the pledge.

Chairman Merchant stated that the tentative millage was set at 9.4492 which is the rolled-back rate. He explained that the rolled-back rate is the millage that would generate the same amount of property tax revenue as the prior year. The public was given opportunity to speak with no one responding.

Commissioner King offered a motion to adopt Resolution 10-12, setting the final millage rate for 2010-11 at 9.4492. Commissioner Music offered a second. The motion passed unanimously.

(Resolution #10-12)

Commissioner King offered a motion to approve the list of budget changes. Commissioner Williams offered a second. The motion passed unanimously.

(List of Budget Changes)

Commissioner Music offered a motion to adopt Resolution #10-13 which approves the final budget for 2010-11. Commissioner Williams offered a second. The motion passed unanimously.

(Resolution #10-13 and Budget)

Commissioner Williams discussed moving Joe Hardy, a temporary worker, into a vacant full time position in District 4. He offered a motion to hire Joe Hardy as full-time retroactive to the first day of the current pay period. Commissioner Music offered a second. The Board discussed that all full time vacancies must be posted for three days before hiring. Commissioner Williams rescinded his motion with Commissioner Music rescinding his second.

There being no further business at this time, the meeting was adjourned.
