

September 14, 2010  
Tentative Budget Hearing  
Bonifay, Florida

The Holmes County Board of Commissioners met in Special Session on the above date with the following members present: Commissioner Ron Monk, Commissioner Kenneth Williams, Commissioner Jim King, Commissioner Phillip Music, and Commissioner Monty Merchant, Chairman of the Board.

Alice Vickers, Deputy Clerk, was present and kept the minutes.

Chairman Merchant opened the meeting the prayer and led the pledge.

Chairman Merchant stated that the proposed millage rate is 9.4492 which is the rolled-back rate. He advised that the rolled-back rate is the millage that will generate the same amount of property tax revenue as the prior year. The public was given an opportunity to discuss this with no one responding.

Commissioner King offered a motion to set the tentative millage at 9.4492 with Commissioner Music offering a second. The motion passed unanimously.

The Board discussed the 2010-11 proposed budget. Commissioner Williams offered a motion to budget \$45,000 for the Health Department and \$10,000 for repairs and maintenance of the Health Department which could be transferred for their use at the end of the year if it was not expended. Commissioner King offered a second. The motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Music offered a motion to adopt the 2010-11 tentative budget with Commissioner Williams offering a second. The motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Merchant announced that the Final Budget Hearing would be held on Monday, September 27, 2010 at 5:01 p.m.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
