

ORDINANCE NO. 81-4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FORMER ORDINANCE NUMBER 73-1; INCREASING THE FEE FOR ISSUING SEPTIC TANK PERMITS; ADDING THE REQUIREMENT THAT AN APPLICATION FOR A SEPTIC TANK CONSTRUCTION PERMIT ISSUED BY THE HOLMES COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT BE SECURED AND DISPLAYED BEFORE ELECTRICAL METERS ARE INSTALLED.

BE IT ENACTED BY the Board of County Commissioners of Holmes County, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1: This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority set forth in Florida Statute 125.66.

SECTION 2: Section 3 of County Ordinance No. 73-1 is hereby amended, increasing the charge for issuing a septic tank permit from \$15.00 to \$25.00.

SECTION 3: The following section 2 is hereby added to said County Ordinance No. 73-1:

"It shall be unlawful for any persons to install any electrical meter or other recording device for measuring or calculating consumption of electrical current for use to any mobile home site or dwelling not previously serviced until there first is obtained, and displayed to such a person an application for a construction permit issued by the Holmes County Health Department pertaining to said mobile home or dwelling.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment and upon a certified copy being duly filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.
