

ORDINANCE NO. 83-1

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY PERSON OR BUSINESS ENTITY FROM SORTING THROUGH OR REMOVING ANY ITEMS WHICH HAVE BEEN PLACED IN THE HOLMES COUNTY SANITARY LANDFILL OR ANY OF THE TRAILERS OR OTHER CONTAINERS USED BY THE COUNTY TO COLLECT GARBAGE; SAID ORDINANCE CONTAINING A SPECIFIC EXCEPTION ALLOWING HOLMES COUNTY TO GRANT SALVAGE RIGHTS AT THE SANITARY LANDFILL; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION HEREOF; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Board of County Commissioners as follows:

Section 1: This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority granted by county government by Florida Statute Section 125.66.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, or business entity to sort through or remove any items of garbage or other materials of any type contained in the Holmes County Sanitary Landfill or in any of the trailers or other containers used in the Holmes County waste management system.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall not apply to persons or business entities who have been granted salvage rights in writing by the said Board of County Commissioners.

Section 4: Any person or business entity who violates the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction, be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars. The violation of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and shall be under the jurisdiction of the County Court.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon being enacted and duly filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.
