

ORDINANCE NO. 98-06

AN ORDINANCE OF HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROHIBITING PERSONS FROM POSSESSING AN OPEN CONTAINER OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE WHILE ON COUNTY OWNED PROPERTY; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to possess an open container of alcoholic beverage while on any County owned property located in Holmes County, Florida.

Section 2: Any person violating this Ordinance, shall upon conviction, be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed 60 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall become effective upon being enacted and filed with the Office of the Secretary of State.
