The Holmes County Board of Commissioners met in a Town Hall meeting at the Noma Town Hall on the above date with the following members present: Commissioner Phillip Music, Commissioner Bobby Sasnett and Commissioner Earl Stafford, Chairman of the Board.

David Corbin, Project Director, was present.

Angie Purvee, Deputy Clerk, was present and kept the minutes.

Chairman Stafford called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Bob Stinebaugh, The Integrity Group, discussed the County's participation in Phase 1 of FEMA's alternative procedures program to place milled asphalt on the following roads:

- Flowing Well Road
- Alex Brown Road
- Bush/Baxley/E. Kelly
- Rucker Lane
- Newton Road

Discussion also included potential roads for Phase 2 of the program, maintenance machinery to be purchased through the program and the August 2020 deadline to complete both phases.


