## BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1:** The definition of the term, Lowest Floor, as it relates to flood damage prevention, shall be:

Lowest floor means the lowest enclosed area (including basement). An unfinished or flood resistant enclosure, usable solely for parking of vehicles, building access or storage in an area other than a basement area is not considered a building's lowest floor; Provided, that such enclosure is not built so as to render the structure in violation of the applicable nonelevation design requirements of Section 60.3 of Title 44 <u>Code of Federal</u> <u>Regulations.</u>

<u>Section 2:</u> This ordinance is being adopted pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 125, Florida Statutes and pursuant to the provisions of Title 44 <u>CFR</u>, Section 59.2 of the NFIP Regulations.

**Section 3:** This ordinance shall become effective upon being enacted and duly filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.
