

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA; EXTENDING THE ONE-CENT SALES SURTAX ON CERTAIN RETAIL SALES IMPLEMENTED AND LEVIED PURSUANT TO COUNTY ORDINANCES NO. 95-04- AND NO. 98-03 FOR AN ADDITIONAL SEVEN (7) YEARS; PROVIDING AUTHORITY FOR ENACTMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR AN EXTRAORDINARY VOTE; PROVIDING FOR SHARING WITH MUNICIPALITIES; PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF MONIES GENERATED; DEFINING A TAXABLE TRANSACTION; PROVIDING RULES OF COLLECTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the provisions of Section 212.055(3), Florida Statutes.

**SECTION 2:** The One-Cent Sales Surtax previously levied by County Ordinance No. 98-03 is hereby extended for an additional seven (7) years, or until September 30, 2013.

**SECTION 3:** All other provisions of Ordinance No. 98-03,, not amended by this ordinance, shall remain in full force and effective.

**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance , when enacted by the Board of County Commissioners of Holmes County, Florida, shall be filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida.
