

ORDINANCE 07-03

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA; AMENDING PRIOR COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 05-05; EXTENDING THE IMPOSITION OF THE SIX (6) CENTS LOCAL OPTION MOTOR FUEL TAX UPON EVERY GALLON OF MOTOR FUEL SOLD IN HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2014; PROVIDING AUTHORITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to Section 336.025

Section 2: The six (6) cents local option motor fuel tax imposed upon every gallon of motor fuel sold in Holmes County, Florida, by prior County Ordinance 05-05, is hereby extended through December 31, 2014.

Section 3: An Interlocal Agreement will be sought between the County and the eligible municipalities within Holmes County, Florida, setting forth how the tax collected during the extension period shall be distributed. If no Interlocal Agreement is agreed upon, the tax collected during the extension period shall be distributed in accordance with the statutory formula provided for in Section 336.025(4)(a).

Section 4: The tax monies collected pursuant to this ordinance shall be used by the County and eligible municipalities for the purposes set forth in Section 336.025(7), Florida Statutes.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall become effective when adopted and filed with the Secretary of State.
