

ORDINANCE NO. 98-04

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 163, LAWS OF FLORIDA, OF A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT FOR HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HOLMES COUNTY:

Section 1: Adoption of Comprehensive Plan Amendment

This Ordinance shall be known as the Eighth Amendment to the Holmes County Comprehensive Plan Ordinance, and consists of change in the land use designation of the following described parcels:

A parcel in section 1, Township 4 North, Range 15 West, lying South of Hwy 90 Approximately 56.7 acres from Residential to Public/Semi-public/Educational, and;

A parcel in Section 16, Township 6 North, Range 15 West, adjacent to Bethlehem School Approximately 15 acres from Agriculture to Public/Semi-public/Educational

Section 2: The Eighth Amendment to the Holmes County Comprehensive Plan does hereby repeal all portions of the Holmes County Comprehensive Plan pursuant to Ordinance No. 97-03 that are inconsistent or in conflict with the Eighth Amendment to the Holmes County comprehensive Plan, and the Holmes County Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended as set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance and consists of the following:

A. Future Land Use Map Amendment.

An official, true and correct copy of all elements of the Holmes County Comprehensive Plan as adopted and amended from time to time shall be maintained by the County Commission or it's designee.

Section 3: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect any other provisions or applications of this Ordinance or the Holmes County Comprehensive Plan which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable.

Section 4: This effective date of this amendment shall be the date a final order is issued by the Department of Community Affairs, or the Administration Commission, finding the amendment in compliance with Section 163.3184, F.S.
