

**AN ORDINANCE OF HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA; IMPOSING A MANDATORY TWO DOLLARS (\$2.00) COURT COSTS ON ALL CASES REFERRED TO IN SECTION 938.01, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF SAID ADDITIONAL COURT COSTS; PROVIDING AUTHORITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 938.15, Florida Statutes, provides that counties may assess an additional \$2.00 costs in all cases wherein a person is convicted for violation of a state penal or criminal statute or convicted for violation of a municipal or county ordinance, and

**WHEREAS**, Section 938.15, Florida Statutes, requires that the monies collected for said \$2.00 additional court costs, must be used for criminal justice education degree programs and training courses, including basic recruit training, for the county's respective officers and support personnel, all in accordance with the provisions of said Section 938.15, Florida Statutes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:**

**Section 1.** Pursuant to the provisions of Section 938.15, Florida Statutes, an additional \$2.00 in court costs is hereby imposed on all every person convicted for violation of a state penal or criminal statute or for violation of a municipal or county ordinance, all as provided for in Section 938.01, Florida Statutes.

**Section 2.** The money derived from the additional \$2.00 in court costs shall be used for those purposes set forth in Section 938.15, Florida Statutes, which purposes relate to criminal justice education and training.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall become effective when enacted and duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
