

ORDINANCE NO. 93-05

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA; AMENDING PRIOR COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 87-05; EXTENDING THE FIVE CENT LOCAL OPTION GAS TAX IMPOSED BY PRIOR COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 87-05 FOR AN ADDITIONAL TEN YEAR PERIOD; PROVIDING FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF A PORTION OF THE PROCEEDS TO ELIGIBLE MUNICIPALITIES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1: This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority granted to Counties in Florida Statute 336.025.

Section 2: The five cent "Local Option Gas Tax" imposed by prior County Ordinance No. 87-05 is hereby extended for a period of ten (10) years, or until September 1, 2007.

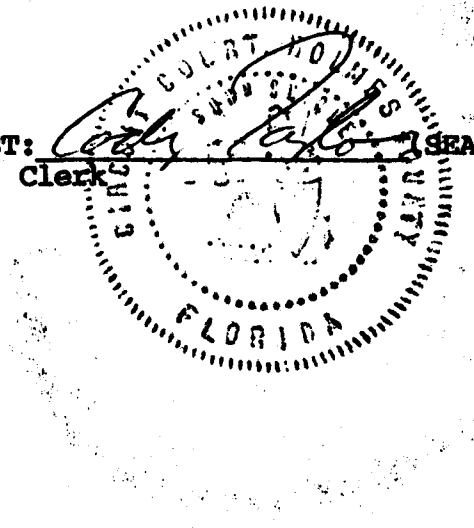
Section 3: An interlocal agreement will be sought between the Board of County Commissioners and the eligible municipalities within Holmes County, Florida, setting forth how the "Local Option Gas Tax" collected during the extension period shall be distributed. If no interlocal agreement is agreed upon, the "Local Option Gas Tax" collected during the extension period shall be distributed in accordance with the statutory formula provided for in Florida Statutes Section 336.025 (4).

Section 4: All other parts or provisions of prior County Ordinance No. 87-05, not amended by this Ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall become effective upon being enacted and duly filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida.
