ORDINANCE NO. 83-4

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A TWO (2) CENT LOCAL OPTION GAS TAX UPON EVERY GALLON OF MOTOR FUEL AND SPECIAL FUEL SOLD IN HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND TAXED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 206, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING THAT THE IMPOSITION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS, BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 1983; PROVIDING FOR DISTRIBUTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 336.025 (4), FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA, as: follows:

Section 1: This ordinance is authorized by Section 336.025, Florida STatutes, (as created by Section 55 of Chapter 93-3, Laws of Florida), and other applicable laws.

Section 2: There is hereby imposed a two(2) cent local option gas tax upon every gallon of motor fuel and special fuel sold in Holmes County and taxed under the provisions of Chapter 206, Florida Statutes.

Section 3: The tax imposition hereby made shall be effective from September 1, 1983, to August 31, 1988, both inclusive.

Section 4: Pursuant to the distribution formula provided for in Section 336.025 (4), Florida Statutes, said formula being based upon the transportation expenditures of the county government and eligible municipalities for the 5 fiscal years preceding 1983, the proceeds of the tax hereby imposed shall be divided and distributed by the Florida Department of Revenue as follows:

Recipient Share of Proceeds
City of Bonifay 12.39 %
Holmes County 87.61%

Section 5: This ordinance is enacted on the <u>Ctl</u> day of <u>July</u>, 1983, upon the affirmative vote of <u>3</u> members of the Board of County Commissioners and shall become effective on September 1, 1983.
