AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A FOUR (4) CENT LOCAL OPTION GAS TAX UPON EVERY GALLON OF MOTOR FUEL AND SPECIAL FUEL SOLD IN HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND TAXED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 206, FLORIDA STATUTES: PROVIDING THAT THE IMPOSITION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE FOR A PERIOD OF TEN (10) YEARS, BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 1985; PROVIDING FOR DISTRIBUTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 336.025 (4), FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HOLMES COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1: This ordinance is authorized by Section 336.025, Florida Statutes, (as created by Section 55 of Chapter 93-3, Laws of Florida,) and other applicable laws.

Section 2: There is hereby imposed a Four (4) cent local option gas tax upon every gallon of motor fuel and special fuel sold in Holmes County and taxed under the provisions of Chapter 206, Florida Statutes.

Section 3: The tax imposition hereby made shall be effective from September 1, 1985, to August 31, 1995, both inclusive.

Section 4: Pursuant to the distribution formula provided for in Section 336.025 (4), Florida Statutes, said formula being based upon the transportation expenditures of the county government and eligible municipalities for the 5 fiscal years preceeding 1985.

Section 5: This ordinance is enacted on the _____ day of ______, 1985, upon the affermative vote of _____ members of the Board of County Commissioners and shall become effective on September 1, 1985.
