Jeff Goodman, County Attorney, and Wesley Adams, County Coordinator, were present.


Angie Purvee, Deputy Clerk, was present and kept the minutes.

Chairman Erickson called the meeting to order at 6:03 pm. Wesley Adams led the prayer and pledge.


Tami Ray, TAMCO-MERIDIAN, LLC, presented the Space Needs Assessment results and discussed the need and costs involved to acquire the old hospital building or the Bonifay Elementary School building as a possible County Annex. Discussion included the following:

- Condition and value of the current county facilities
- Judiciary demand and Florida Statute requirement for providing holding cells in the courthouse
- Operation and maintenance costs of the current county facilities
- Current needs assessment versus future needs assessment
- Office space requirements per employee
- Estimated improvement cost of each facility
- Different funding sources and scenarios
- Rehabilitating old buildings versus building new county annex
- Creating a revenue stream with franchise tax
- Timeline of remodeling versus building new
- Application deadlines for grants and the grant process
