Chairman Stafford called the Special Session to order at 5:06 p.m. Nathan Nolan, County Attorney, led the prayer and pledge.


Commissioner Music offered the motion to accept the agenda. Commissioner Newsom offered the second and the motion passed unanimously.


Angie Purvee, Finance Director, presented a list of additional expenditures, proposed cuts and additional revenue sources from the 2022-23 Budget Committee meeting held July 26, 2022. Ms. Purvee explained that the Budget Committee balanced the proposed 2022-23 Budget using the current millage rate of 9.4916. Commissioner Erickson offered the motion to set the 2022-23 proposed millage rate to the current millage rate of 9.4916. Commissioner Newsom offered the second and the motion passed unanimously.

Angie Purvee, Finance Director, requested the Board schedule a tentative Budget Hearing between September 3, 2022, and September 18, 2022. Ms. Purvee stated that the School Board will meet on September 12, 2022, therefore that date is not available. Commissioner Music offered a motion to schedule the Tentative Budget Hearing for 5:01 p.m. on September 6, 2022. Commissioner Good offered the second and the motion passed unanimously.
